



Moving OpCon to the Cloud

Why is it worth it to move OpCon to the cloud?

Hosting OpCon in the cloud means less work and costs for you and greater security for your environment. With OpCon in the cloud, you'll:



Eliminate the costs of expensive IT hardware, software licensing fees, and the need to hire additional staff to support your infrastructure.



No longer need to manage a data center or worry about maintaining or upgrading your processing and storage capacity to manage increased workloads.



Free up your IT team's time and resources for more strategic projects that support your organization's mission-critical priorities, keeping you ahead of your competition.



Get a level of security that simply can't be replicated on-premises with Microsoft Azure, our cloud host, including military-grade, 256-bit AES encryption.



Ensure your applications and data are securely backed up and protected in the cloud if you experience a natural disaster or major disruption, so you can keep running your mission-critical operations as normal even in a crisis.

What's the process?

We have a 100% success rate helping customers move OpCon to the cloud. Here's how we'll do it:

1. After your contract is signed, you'll be assigned an automation consultant.
2. Your automation consultant will schedule an initial kick-off meeting with you. They'll gather key information about your OpCon environment needs once in the cloud and then schedule dates for each part of the process.
3. All of your OpCon instances will be set up with the relay with logins provided to you.
4. If you're already an OpCon customer, you'll upload your databases to our SFTP site. We'll then start with a test lift and conversion. Then, more testing will be done to confirm all your jobs, schedules, and users have been successfully uploaded.
5. After you sign off on testing, we'll do a final lift and convert your schedules, and confirm all your jobs, schedules, and users are ready to go.

How long does the migration take?

Migrating OpCon to the cloud takes about two to four weeks on average, but we can typically move as quickly as you'd like to go. We can create a cloud instance in as little as 30 minutes, and we've helped customers go live after signing their contract within a week.

What will you need from us?

We'll need your help getting the relay installed. We have step-by-step instructions for this process if you'd like to handle that yourself, or we can help you do that.

Additionally, if you have an older version of Enterprise Manager or older agents, your automation consultant will need to work with you to update those to the latest version in OpCon before the migration process can continue.
